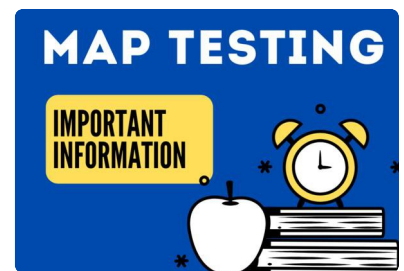

Upcoming MAPs Testing for 1st – 8th-grade Students

During the weeks of October 16 – November 3, your child will take tests called Measures of Academic Progress™ (MAP). We give our students MAP tests two times each school year to determine a child's instructional level, to assist teachers in differentiating instruction, and to measure academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Reading, Language Arts, and Math. Your child will take the tests on a computer.



MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for your child's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. And with MAP tests, we can administer shorter tests and use less class time while still receiving detailed, accurate information about your child's growth. During the next testing period, your child will spend a total of about 2-2.5 hours completing these tests.
