## MIDDLE SCHOOL CONFERENCES

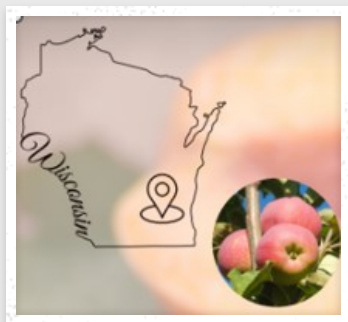
### **HOT LUNCH NIBBLES AND NOTES**
