

During October, we WALKED WITH JESUS and showed love for our "neighbors" by collecting new and gently used shoes for those in need. Thank you to everyone that gave so generously. By participating in this activity, our students witnessed our school community living out the Corporal Work of Mercy - Clothing the Naked. As October comes to a close, I encourage you to reflect as a family and discuss all the other ways you have shown love



to your "neighbor" this month. Have you practiced any of the other Spiritual or Corporal Works of Mercy? How has your family WALKED WITH JESUS?

Over the previous two years, the pandemic and the constantly changing guidelines requiring quarantine, isolation, virtual schooling, and everything else we had to navigate made the traditional attendance policies and practices challenging to navigate and enforce. However, now that we are back to a more "normal" school year, we felt it necessary to remind you of the attendance laws and policies we are required to follow. The attendance policy in its entirety can be located in the Family Handbook on pages 4 and 5, but there are a few specific items I would like to highlight:

- Waukesha Catholic will comply with the compulsory school attendance laws defined by Wisconsin State Statute 118.15.
- Parents/guardians may excuse their child from attendance in school for up to ten (10) days per school year. A medical excuse will be required for any additional absence(s) exceeding ten (10) days per school year; otherwise, the absence(s) will be considered unexcused. As a courtesy, we will provide proactive notifications informing you when you are approaching the 10-day threshold.
- Parents or legal guardians must provide the school with the reason for their child's absence. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide verbal or written reasons for their child's absence before 9:00 am on the day of the absence.
- Failure to report an absence, by call or note, by the end of the next day following the absence will result in the absence being unexcused.

Please also note, in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 118.15, we are required by law to send a written notification when a child has been absent or tardy without an acceptable excuse for a total of five or more days in a semester.

URGENT - SETON VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!

As you may have seen or heard, the Elizabeth Seton Volleyball Championships are coming up at the end of this month, beginning on Monday, October 31 and running each night until Sunday, November 6. The Seton is a 74 team, three division, invitation-only tournament to end the 8th-grade volleyball season. This tournament is sanctioned by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and serves as their championships. It is the volleyball equivalent to the Padre Serra basketball tournament. The tournament is held at the Milwaukee Sting Center in Menomonee Falls (Monday-Friday) and at Catholic Memorial High School (Saturday-Sunday).

What you may not have known is that this tournament is run by the Waukesha Catholic Athletic Association. The tournament is spearheaded by the Waukesha Catholic Athletic Board and The Seton Tournament Committee. The proceeds from the tournament go towards the Waukesha County Catholic School Tuition Assistance Program, the Foundation for Religious Retirement, and Waukesha Catholic Athletics. This tournament serves as our single-largest athletic fundraiser each year, and it is through these proceeds that we are able to keep our athletic fees lower to allow for more 5th-8th grade students to participate in Waukesha Catholic athletics.

In order to make this tournament run, we need your help! We are in need of parents to serve a variety of roles as volunteers each night. We have over 150 parent volunteer slots (all 2-2 ½ hours). As **Guest Services/Crowd Control** people, you would stand near specified courts to help make sure that no one walks behind the courts while play is going on, that spectators remain in specified areas around the courts so that players have room to play, and assist the Seton Committee/Athletic Board member who is in charge of the crowds that night. Ideally, we need seven parents to help in each of two shifts each weeknight (14 parents total). We are also in need of filling slots at the **admissions** tables, with four parents in each of two shifts (eight parents total); you must be a parent to do this and the same household is not allowed

to work the same admissions table—also, children are not allowed to handle cash under any circumstance.

We are also in need of up to eight 5th-8th grade students to serve as flip-scorers at the tables each night in two shifts for the eight courts we use. They would flip the score and mark it in an iPad for online viewers. Middle school students may use this for service hours at school.

Finally, we need your support for our 8th-grade teams who are participating this year—the boys 8th-grade team plays Monday night, October 31, starting at 5:30 pm, while the girls 8th-grade team starts Tuesday, November 1, at 7:30 pm.
