# **KOVALESKI'S KEYNOTES**

# An Advent Reflection (Adapted from PrinScripts - Series 1)

"Life is not about being better than someone else. It is about striving to be better than you used to be." (Author Unknown) St. Augustine had another good insight when he wrote: "When people choose to withdraw far from a fire, the fire continues to give warmth, but they grow cold. When people choose to withdraw far



from the light, the light continues to be bright in itself, but they are in darkness. This is also the case when people withdraw from God."

And withdraw from God we all do, not out of disbelief necessarily, but mostly out of forgetfulness because we are just too busy with the rest of life. Take, for example, the Bethlehem Innkeeper who told Mary and Joseph that there was no room for them at his inn. This did not mean he was a bad person; he was just very busy caring for his customers, providing for their needs, and keeping the peace. Unfortunately, when the most important birth in history took place in his backyard, he missed it entirely, not because he was a bad person, he was just too busy.

With Christmas just around the corner, we might be too busy to give attention to what we are actually commemorating. Those who live "by the cash register" will do everything they can to keep our attention on our wallets and purses. The Three Wise Men seem to have truly understood the Christmas event. They spent many weeks in anticipation as they traveled from their homeland to Bethlehem. When they arrived, their purpose was to honor the newborn child, and out of courtesy, they brought one gift each.

We, too, have the opportunity for a period of anticipation in the Season of Advent. Advent is celebrated every year for weeks before Christmas Day. Of course, Advent is a constant season for, within our own lives, we are continuously waiting to become, to discover, to complete, and to fulfill. Hope, struggle, fear, and expectations, are all part of our Advent experience. God does not come to us from the sky, he comes to us in the daily story of our lives in people, places, and events.

Advent invites us to prepare for the commemoration of God's coming by taking time to have a closer look inside ourselves away from the busy outside. This looking inside is not about remorse or regret, nor about listing ways life over the past year could have been different; it's not about wishing we were better people. It's about forward movement, getting new bearings, and relying more on God for directions. It's about a fresh start, getting closer to the "fire" and the "light" that are God's love and compassion.

- Illness policy: As a reminder, our policy states that students/staff with symptoms of
  infectious illness, including COVID-19, should stay home and are strongly encouraged to get
  tested for COVID-19. Fever, nausea, rashes, diarrhea, earache, cough, etc., are symptoms that
  parents should have checked before sending a child to school. For illnesses other than
  COVID-19, students and staff should remain home until symptoms improve AND they are free
  of fever, diarrhea, and vomiting for 24 hours without the use of medication. Keeping sick
  children home significantly reduces the spread of illness among our school community. Thank
