Do the right thing regardless of what others might think.

Make the Season Bright with HOLY MOMENTS!

This Week's Video

(Video Note: The Holy Moments videos shared each week are titled using the prompt from the week before as they "recap" the previous week's prompt and introduce us to the new prompt for the upcoming week.)

The greatest moments of history happened when people did the right thing, even in the face of great opposition. In a world often filled with conflicting messages and societal pressures, our Catholic faith IS our guide. At the heart of the this week's prompt is the idea that creating a holy moment is not contingent upon external validation but is, instead, a commitment to living out our faith even in the face of adversity. Jesus himself was no stranger to societal expectations and challenges, yet he demonstrated to us the importance of doing what is right, even when faced with opposition.

In the classroom and on the playground, our students are presented with countless opportunities to make choices that reflect our Catholic values. It could be standing up to those that are unkind to others, choosing kindness over gossip, or helping a classmate in need. These seemingly small decisions have the power to change ordinary moments into Holy Moments, as they are infused with the love and compassion that Jesus taught us.

Tips to Create This Holy Moment:

- Unfollow any pages or people on social media who stand for unholy moments.
- Focus during class, work, or Mass, even if other people aren't.
- Choose not to gossip and speak kindly about others instead.
