Christmas Choir Concert

- Students should arrive at Waukesha South High School at 6:15 pm.
- Students should leave their personal belongings (coats, hats, mittens, etc.) with their parents.
- 3rd-8th grade students should proceed to the library (located in the hallway to the north of the auditorium) when they arrive.
- K3-2nd grade students should proceed to the hallway outside of the library (north of the auditorium) when they arrive.
