

## THIS WEEK'S HOLY MOMENTS PROMPT IS:

Ask someone how their day was and really listen to their response.



#### This Week's Video

(Video Note: The Holy Moments videos shared each week are titled using the prompt from the week before as they "recap" the previous week's prompt and introduce us to the new prompt for the upcoming week.)

When you give someone your complete attention, you show them that they are important and respected—and that's a powerful thing to do. Remember, some moments are holy. Some moments are unholy. And you get to decide!

Tips to Create This Holy Moment:

- Make eye contact when you are in conversation with someone.
- Keep your technology away during conversations.
- Ask people questions and remember small details they tell you.

  the new prompt each week and then discuss it daily. As you go through the week, color in the
  squares for each day a family member was successful in completing the Holy Moments
  prompt and discuss how that activity brought him/her closer to Christ.
- Students at each Campus will pray The Stations of the Cross throughout Lent. Dates/times will be listed in Campus Connection or on individual campus calendars.
- Prayer buddy classrooms will be praying with and for each other during Lent. Each classroom will have a "Prayer Jar" with specific prayer intentions from children in their classroom or

buddy classroom. Each day an intention will be chosen, read, and prayed for by the students.

- Students are being encouraged to FAST from snack on Wednesdays during Lent. This is optional, but encouraged.
- Both campuses will participate again this year in Catholic Madness Fan Favorites edition.
   This is a fun and engaging way for our students to learn about 32 of the "Fan Favorite Saints" and the contributions they have made to the world.
- We will host a Lenten Retreat for both Campuses at St. Mary on Holy Thursday. More details will be included in future Campus Connections.
- Individual classrooms will also participate in miscellaneous classroom activities.

#### Message from Fr. Chuck

This is not an easy message to compose so I will just tear off the band-aid and put it out there.



There is a strong possibility that with the next priest movement in June I will be leaving Waukesha. I say "strong possibility" because there is a process that needs to be followed and only God knows the definitive outcome. We will keep you posted with details as they solidify.

There is a parish that I have been aware of and have been asked to look at that I could be asked to serve. I have visited with them, and it seems to be a lovely place.

Now, it will be left to the Holy Spirit and the process of the Priest Placement Board to determine what happens next. (In the meantime, Waukesha will also be open listed so a priest can be assigned here if I am moved to a new ministry.)

This is my 7th year here. As an associate pastor, it has been a longer assignment than what is normal. I have been here longer than any of my other placements in my ministry. It will not be easy to leave; however, ministry is not always about comfort and ease. Sometimes things need to move in order for things to grow and in order for them to be where the Spirit needs them to be. I am praying for both of those things to happen within the big picture.

I pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us all in this (and many matters). I invite you to do the same and to pray for whomever will be here come June, be it I or someone else.

## **Seton Scholarship Information**

Each year, the Seton Volleyball Tournament benefits The Waukesha County Catholic Elementary Schools Tuition Assistance Fund, which is used to make Catholic school education a real possibility for those students who may not otherwise be able to afford full tuition. Tax season is quickly approaching. A simple form can help you deduct up to \$4,000 for K-8th grade tuition on your state income taxes. To help you fill out your Schedule PS form you will find your tuition payment summary in FACTS. Please follow the instructions below to view/print your payment history for the 2023 calendar year.




A study involving 4700 children published in the British Journal of Nutrition looked at the effect of diet at different childhood ages on arterial stiffness at age 17.

Arteries carry blood rich in oxygen and nutrients from the heart to the rest of the body. Stiff arteries can drive up blood pressure, increasing stress on the heart and raise the risk for heart attack and stroke.

The study found children ages 7 and 10 with diets high in calories, fat, and sugar, and low in fiber, had stiffer arteries at the age of 17 than those with diets lower in these nutrients.

The study also found DECREASED arterial stiffness with children whose diets were higher in fruit



CFI School meals already meet strict requirements set forth by the USDA to be low in calories, sodium, and saturated fat. Every day students get the choice of a fruit and a vegetable. You can feel good about your students and children taking school lunch and know that their heart is benefiting from it!
