

Tax season is quickly approaching. A simple form can help you deduct up to \$4,000 for K-8th grade tuition on your state income taxes. Click **here** for the Private K-12 Tuition Tax Deduction-Parent Packet for 2023. For questions regarding tax forms, you will need to contact your personal accountant.

To help you fill out your Schedule PS form you will find your tuition payment summary in FACTS. Please follow the instructions below to view/print your payment history for the 2023 calendar year.

Step 1: Sign in to FACTS at https://online.factsmgt.com

Step 2: Select 'View Details'

Step 3: Select 'View Payment Summary' **Page will open in another window or tab.**

Step 4: Select the year and then 'Print'

NOTE: This report will show the total paid for each of the accounts. You can select a year or a date range for this summary. This will also include the School's Federal Tax ID and address. A study involving 4700 children published in the British Journal of Nutrition looked at the effect of diet at different childhood ages on arterial stiffness at age 17.

Arteries carry blood rich in oxygen and nutrients from the heart to the rest of the body. Stiff arteries can drive up blood pressure, increasing stress on the heart and raise the risk for heart attack and stroke.



The study found children ages 7 and 10 with diets high in calories, fat, and sugar, and low in fiber, had stiffer arteries at the age of 17 than those with diets lower in these nutrients.

The study also found DECREASED arterial stiffness with children whose diets were higher in fruit

Hilltopper Robotics Team 1732, made up of students from Divine Savior Holy Angels and Marquette University High Schools. is a FIRST® Robotics Competition team. FIRST is an

organization dedicated to developing today's students into tomorrow's science and technology leaders and innovators. One way that FIRST® accomplishes this is by offering fun-filled robotics programs that give elementary, middle, and high school students hands-on experience designing, building, and programming robots.

In addition to building an awesome competition robot, our team has a goal of promoting science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) fields within the Greater Milwaukee community. One way we do this is through our annual "Design-A-Robot Poster Contest." The objectives of the contest are to help grade school students become interested in STEM, give them an opportunity to see what our team does, and show how cool robotics can be.

We invite 1st through 5th-grade students to enter our 2023 "Design-A-Robot Poster Contest!"

The contest theme for 2024 is "Think about something you would like to create. Then design a cool robot that could make it easier."
