**Tuition Update**: Thank you for your continued support of Waukesha Catholic and for making Catholic education a priority in your child's life. The administration, Finance Committee, School Board, and pastors have worked diligently to determine appropriate tuition rates for the 2024-25 school year. We understand that tuition costs are a significant investment for many families, and we have taken steps to keep costs as low as possible while maintaining the high level of education and quality resources our school provides. However, like many other educational institutions and organizations, we are faced with significant cost increases, related to:

- Educational resources, instructional materials and technology: These educational resources are necessary for us to continue to provide and outstanding, quality education yet they are a high cost to our school.
- **Safety and Security:** Although, we have already invested in security/safety measures, continuous upgrades and maintenance are necessary.
- **Teacher Salaries and Benefits**: Insurance and other benefit premiums are on the rise. Also, in order to retain our amazing staff and recruit highly qualified teachers, we are committed to getting/maintaining teacher salaries to 80% of their public school counterparts.
- **Other significant cost increases**: Contracted services, office equipment/printing costs, field trip, and transportation expenses, etc.

After much prayer and thoughtful consideration, the School Board has approved a <u>3% tuition</u> increase for the 2024-25 school year.

Please refer to this **FINANCIAL INFORMATION SHEET** for the 2024-25 tuition rates.

#### A few items to note:

- In our continued effort to have all items related to the cost of education reflected in one tuition amount, the following are included in the cost of your tuition:
  - Field trip fees, with the exception of 6th-grade camp. You will not have to pay separately for field trips. (This does not include any costs incurred for extra-curricular or club events).
  - Technology Fees This fee was previously charged in addition to tuition but is now included in the cost. These monies are dedicated to technology upgrades.
  - Registration Fee/Tuition Deposit This fee was previously charged in addition to tuition but is now included in the cost. This fee is paid at the time of registration and is credited

to the tuition owed for the 2024-25 school year.

- Tuition alone does not cover the cost of your child's education. In addition to your tuition, we depend on support from our parishes and monies raised by third source funding to help cover the remaining costs.
- Tuition contracts will be sent home to families in mid-May.

We remain committed to providing the best possible education for your children and believe this tuition increase is necessary for us continue to do so. We appreciate your understanding and support as we look forward to next school year.

Archdiocese of Milwaukee Safeguarding All of God's Family Safe Environment Week - Proclamation

WHEREAS, Safe Environment Week is for every parish and school, as well as the entire faith community to focus, at the same time, on the importance of keeping our children and youth safe;

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect are societal problems whose prevention depend on involvement among people throughout the faith community;

WHEREAS, our children are our most valuable resources and will shape the future of not only the Archdiocese of Milwaukee but also the entire Church;

WHEREAS, the theme for this years' Safe Environment Week will be "Protecting our Children starts with working as a Community on Prevention.";

WHEREAS, acknowledging that as a Church we have much work to do to rebuild the trust that has been broken;

WHEREAS, we acknowledge that as bishops, clergy and church leaders we must work together as a community to increase awareness about child abuse and neglect and work to promote the social and emotional well-being of children, youth and families in a safe, healthy and nurturing environment;

THEREFORE, I, Archbishop Jerome E. Listecki proclaim the week of April 21st – April 27th, 2024, as Safe Environment Week in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. I ask that all participate and acknowledge each other with the love and mercy of God the Father.

Safe Environment Week April 21 - April 27

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee recognizes April 21–April 27 as Safe Environment Awareness Week. Each year in the month of April, which is recognized around the country as child abuse prevention month, we dedicate a week to elevating the general awareness of the Church's efforts to keep our children safe. We want people to know that we are committed to maintaining safe environments in our parishes and schools through adult child abuse prevention training; criminal background checks for all clergy, volunteers working with minors, and employees; safety training for children in each grade level; and adhering to all mandatory reporting requirement laws.

#### **Busing Request Form – ACT NOW**

#### Alternate Location/Day Care Request Forms are now available online at Alternate location daycare

Use this form if you would like to use the shuttle to SWC instead of your AM or PM bus route. Students will only be routed to/from one (1) AM location and one (1) PM location Monday - Friday.

This form is due no later than **Sunday**, <u>June 30, 2024</u>. If this form is received **after Sunday**, **June 30** it will remain in the que until paperwork is processed after school begins in the fall.

#### Deadline for Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) Ends Tomorrow!

Attention parents of students entering K4, K5, or 1st Grade (in the 2024-25 school year): Waukesha Catholic will continue to participate in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program for the 2024-25 school year. The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) allows students to attend Waukesha Catholic, tuition-free, if certain eligibility criteria are met. Waukesha Catholic, on behalf of the pupil's parent or guardian, receives a state aid payment for each eligible student. That aid payment or "voucher" covers the entire cost of the eligible student's tuition. **The open application period to apply for the WPCP ends tomorrow, Thursday, April 18, 2024.** The application and more information can be found at: <u>https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/</u>.

Attention Current WPCP Families: The WPCP Application portal is now open. If your family currently has a WPCP voucher, please log in to your WPCP account and check in for the year. Review your family profile, update addresses (if applicable), and complete your 2024-25 application for the new school year. Every current WPCP family must complete this step. You will not need to provide your financial information again unless you are adding a new student from your family. You are required to provide proof of residency. Please send a current form of residency documentation to Meghan D. Gorzalski, Director of Admissions and Marketing, via email or in a sealed envelope to the school office. Proof of residency for current WPCP families must be sent to Meghan as soon as possible, but <u>no later than Thursday, April 18, 2024</u>. If sending via email, feel free to take a clear photograph of a 2023 W2, a current electric, water, or cable bill dated January 2024-April 18, 2024 to Meghan D. The Board of Directors has approved Waukesha Catholic's participation in the Special Needs Scholarship Program for the 2024-25 school year. The Special Needs Scholarship Program (SNSP) allows a student with a disability who meets certain eligibility requirements to receive a statefunded scholarship. The school receives a state aid payment for each eligible student, which is used to provide the necessary resources and/or programming to meet the student's disability. By participating in this program, we hope to provide additional staffing and program resources to meet the needs of our students, primarily in the areas of speech and language and learning difficulties. We hope to hire a part-time speech pathologist and part-time math intervention teacher for the 2024-25 school year.

If your child qualifies for this program, Ms. Kovaleski or a member of our Learning Support Team will reach out to you soon to discuss eligibility, answer any questions, and, if interested, explain the next steps in the process.


#### **New Breakfast Option at Waukesha Catholic!**
