



Retired Chromebooks Available to Families

Waukesha Catholic has replaced several carts of chromebooks that have reached their auto-update expiration. They can no longer be used for MAP and Forward testing, so they have been taken out of service. Although these chromebooks can no longer be used at school, they are still functional. As a result, we are offering them to



families who need devices for their students. They will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Here are some things to know before requesting a chromebook for your family:

- Usage of the chromebook is not monitored by Waukesha Catholic and websites are not restricted in any way.
- The chromebook is close to the end of its useful life, and we do not know how long it will be usable.
- When the chromebook is no longer usable, like any other electronic device, it must be disposed of properly, not placed in the trash
- Waukesha Catholic is no longer responsible for the device, and we will not be able to provide support for the device.
