Welcome to the 2022-23 School Year!

It is so good to be back! I really enjoy seeing all the smiling children (and parents) on the first days of school. There is so much anticipation and excitement for the amazing school year we have ahead of us!

For this week's Kovaleski's Keynote, I simply wanted to share a few updates/reminders:

Hot Lunch: Due to the change in the Hot Lunch program this year, if you want your child to eat hot lunch it is imperative that you sign him/her up in advance. We order the number of meals based on how many students have signed up for lunch each day. If you have not signed your child up for hot lunch, please send them with a cold lunch.

- Directions for Ordering: We will now be using LunchTime to pre-order and pay for hot lunch. Even if you have Free Lunch Benefits, you must set up an account and pre-order meals for your child. Please use the exact spelling of your child's name and his/her ID to set up your account. You only need one account per family. (You should have received a letter from your child's teacher with their ID#). Directions on how to create your account were sent in a previous email. Pre-ordering does not require payment but must be done to have your child on the list for that day's meal service. Accounts will be charged at the time the meal is served, so please make sure to add funds appropriately. Please order for the whole month. (There is a cut off of six days, so you will not be able to pre-order meals less than six days before the service date.)
- If you believe your child would qualify for free or reduced lunch prices based on your families income and have not yet applied, please complete the online application:

Waukesha Catholic Booster Club Spirit Wear Sale!


