Bus Update: As many of you are aware, two of our Waukesha Catholic bus routes were canceled at the beginning of the year due to a driver shortage - Routes 2 and 13. Unfortunately, these routes are

still not operating. I continue to advocate for our families in the hopes of getting this issue resolved soon. In the meantime, the school district has started a weekly communication with their parents with status updates. I asked if our families could be included. Due to the fact we are not connected to the district's messaging system and unable to receive those messages, they will be posting their weekly message to the transportation website:

First Student continues to have new hires progress through the training program and some will be starting behind-the-wheel training next week. In addition, First Student held their first online hiring event via Indeed. From this event, seven interviews have been scheduled. It is important for families to set up and be able to access their Parent Portal accounts. The Parent Portal is where parents can view assessment grades, attendance records, and report cards. Additionally, this year we will be introducing a forms and registration feature to the Parent Portal that will allow us to collect information from families through the Parent Portal. This will help us collect and process information faster and more efficiently and save money on printing costs.
