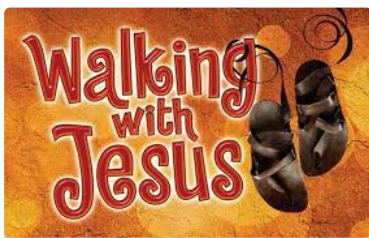

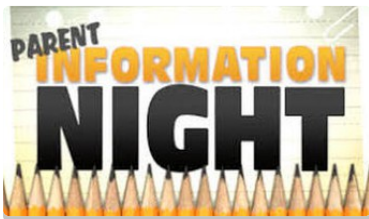
HELP WANTED IMMEDIATELY - BEFORE AND AFTER CARE

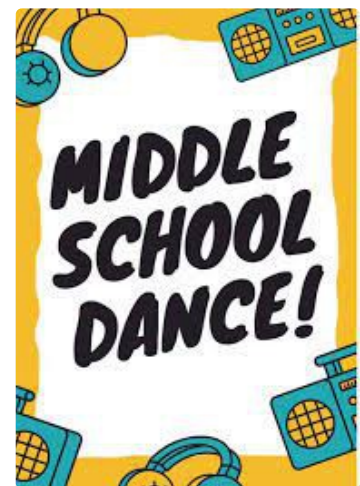
