LET'S DO THIS!!**

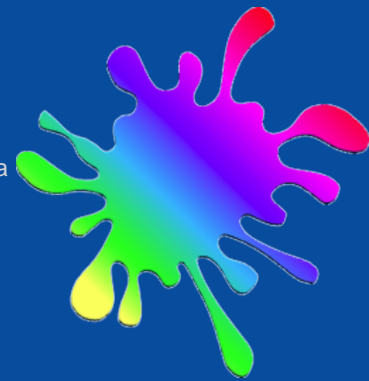

Seton Tournament

Dear Waukesha Catholic Parents:

I'm sure many of you have heard about the Elizabeth Seton Volleyball Championships (The Seton), and many of you may have seen our two blue banners hanging in the gym at St. Joe's Campus, but what you may not have realized is that Waukesha Catholic is the host school for The Seton each year. Now in its 12th year, The Seton is the single-largest fundraiser for our athletic programs at Waukesha Catholic. The invitation-only tournament is a week-long, 84 team, 3 division volleyball competition featuring teams from all over the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. The tournament itself is run here in Waukesha, with weeknight matches at Center Court near the Waukesha Airport, and weekend matches at Catholic Memorial High School.

The tournament itself raises money for three main causes: Waukesha County Catholic School Tuition Assistance, the Foundation for Religious Retirement, and Waukesha Catholic Athletics. It is through our portion of the proceeds that we are able to provide the athletic programs we offer at the fees we typically keep lower than most other schools.

To help run such a large endeavor, the Waukesha Catholic Athletic Board and The Seton Tournament Committee work hard to organize and lead the many areas of responsibility. These two groups need your help. Each weeknight of the tournament we need between 10-15 parents to help serve as volunteers for admissions, crowd control, and assistants. During the Final Four of the tournament, we need between 5-10 parent volunteers to help. We are also in need of students to volunteer to flip-score cards on each of the courts during the matches.

Please check out the SignUpGenius links for both parent volunteers and student flip scorers (students can earn service hours). Parents, please check the sign-up carefully, as some roles require athletic board members to fill. In areas of need, your help can make all the difference in continuing to offer such a great program for all of the student-athletes who share their love of volleyball and their Catholic faith.
