WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect are societal problems whose prevention depend on involvement among people throughout the faith community;

WHEREAS, our children are our most valuable resources and will shape the future of not only the Archdiocese of Milwaukee but also the entire Church;

WHEREAS, the theme for this year's Safe Environment Week is "Serve with Love." As a faith community, together we focus on the importance of God's protecting love that surrounds each and every one of His children;

WHEREAS, when we fully live the words of Pope Francis when he says "only those who serve with love are able to protect," we ensure an environment in which all are God's children are safe;

### ***Non – Uniform Day Reminder***

As the weather warms up, please review the guidelines for non-uniform attire. The following dress is not allowed as it may disrupt the educational setting:

- No beach attire, lounge/pajama wear
- Shirts should have sleeves for both boys and girls
- No part of any undergarment is to be visible while standing or sitting
- No bare midriffs
- No strapless tops, spaghetti strap, tank tops, off the shoulder or low cut tops
- No open back shirts
- No short shorts, or skirts, even if worn with leggings (must be an appropriate length-fingertip test)
- No hats, bandannas, scarves, or other headwear during the school day.
- Students are expected to remove headwear upon entering the building. No coats, jackets, or outerwear during the school day. Outerwear must be stored in the student's locker.
- No leggings or jeggings or any other "tight fitting pants"
- No profanity, no reference to drugs, tobacco, alcohol or promiscuity, no reference to gangs or designs in poor taste on any clothing

Due to our knowledge and understanding of the students, classroom teachers, classroom dynamics, and curriculum expectations, placement requests will only be considered for extenuating circumstances and if the rationale is justified. 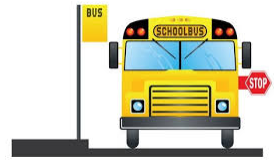
