Time Change For June 9th Mass - End Of Trimester Awards Assembly



The start time for our final campus Mass on June 9th has been changed to **9:45 a.m.** Our final awards assembly of the year will immediately follow Mass. Please join us as we recognize our students for their many accomplishments during the third trimester!

Attention St. Mary Campus and St. Joseph Campus Families – An Important Note Regarding Thursday, June 8th

Tomorrow, June 8th, the St. Joseph Campus students will be spending the entire day at St. Mary Campus. In the morning, the SJC students will be helping with the Fun Day activities for the SMC students. Then, in the afternoon, the SJC students will have their Field Day event on the grounds of SMC. For this reason, the St. Joseph Campus students who ride the bus will be dropped off and picked up at St. Mary Campus. St. Joseph Campus students who are dropped-off/picked up using the carline will need to be dropped-off/picked-up at St. Mary Campus.

We have provided two maps, one for morning arrival and one for afternoon dismissal, to illustrate how the carline process at St. Mary Campus will operate for this day.

Morning Arrival

- St. Joseph Campus students who ride the bus will be dropped off at St. Mary Campus.
- St. Joseph Campus families should review the map for how the carline at St. Mary Campus operates.
- From the perspective of the St. Mary Campus families, the morning carline procedure will be unchanged.

Afternoon Dismissal

Bus Students

- St. Joseph Campus students who ride the bus in the afternoon will get on their bus at St. Mary Campus.
- St. Mary Campus students who ride the bus home will see no change in their dismissal procedure.

Students Picked Up By Car-line

In order to facilitate the safe and orderly pickup of students by vehicle during this afternoon, there will be two different car-lines. Included is a map showing how vehicles should enter and exit the parking lot. Please be sure to use the correct parking lot entrance so that you enter the proper car-line.

- All St. Mary Campus families will use the "normal" carline entrance to pick up their students, entering the lot from northbound Hartwell Avenue. If they also have a student at St. Joseph Campus, those students will be stationed by their sibling in this carline. These vehicles will exit the parking lot by driving ahead, up the hill behind the school and exiting onto Newhall Avenue by making a left turn only.
- St. Joseph Campus families who do not have a sibling at St. Mary Campus will enter the parking lot from southbound Hartwell Avenue, turning left into the parking lot, forming a second carline on the north side of the lot. These vehicles will also exit the parking lot by driving up the hill and turning left onto Newhall Ave.
