Today, start earning money for your school and credits for your child's tuition! (What is Scrip? See page 2 for an explanation)

*Order this summer and pick up the order at your Parish!
Summer order dates: June 20, July 11 and 25, August 8 and 29.*

1. Register on line if you are a new user. (see page 3 of this packet) If you ordered last year – no need to register again- just start ordering.
2. Place your order on line – make sure delivery directions are correct (child's current school/classroom/grade.)
3. Get a copy of your order and check (if you pay by check) into the school office (or administrative offices this summer) by 9:00 a.m. on Monday morning. (If you pay with Presto Pay-debit from your account- no need to send in any paperwork.)
4. Pick up your order on Thursday, or your child will bring it home.

Think *SCRIP* for every purchase you make!

Who wants to give money to our school? SCRIP retailers do!!

\$CRIP, it's the fundraising program that works while you shop.

Scrip is simply another word for gift certificates or gift cards from national and local retailers. They're the same gift cards that you buy at the store. Many popular retailers participate in our Scrip program including Pick & Save, KwikTrip, Chancery and many others. You're probably asking yourself how these stores help us raise money. It's simple – Scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift cards to our school at a discount. School families buy the cards for full face value, they redeem them for full face value, and our school keeps the difference as revenue. Everyone wins:

- ◆ The retailer gets cash up front and repeat business ...
- ◆ You get a powerful fundraising alternative that involves no selling ...
- ◆ Our school gets a regular source of revenue.

The beauty of Scrip is that you put your regular household shopping dollars to work. Just spend your regular shopping dollars with Scrip at the stores that participate in the Scrip program and our school earns between 2% and 20% of your purchase value!

A percentage of the Scrip profits will be shared with participating families in the form of **Waukesha Catholic tuition credits**. A participating family will receive 50% of the Scrip profit generated by their family's weekly order in the form of Waukesha Catholic tuition credits. The tuition credit will be accumulated from July 1st through June 30th. The remaining profit will be used by Waukesha Catholic to offset operating expenses for all campuses within the Waukesha Catholic system.

The current year credits are applied to tuition in the following year. If your final child is graduating, you may apply the Scrip credits to a portion of the graduating expenses. Scrip credits accumulate all year long, there must be a minimum of \$30 in total accumulated credits from the entire year. This credit will apply to your July tuition bill.

How do you buy Scrip? Go on line at www.shopwithscrip.com. Register and start ordering right away. Waukesha Catholic # 8AL3CL461142

Drop off a copy of the order and your check at the school office or return it in your weekly envelope. The weekly order deadline is Monday mornings at 9:00 a.m. The Scrip is available for pick up on Thursday afternoon (or it can be sent home with your child).

How do you use Scrip? Simply present the retailer's gift card at the time of purchase. It is treated as cash. You may also pay your charge account balance at Kohl's using gift cards purchased through Scrip!

Why should I use Scrip? The retailers that participate in the Scrip program are willing to give our school between 2% and 20% of every dollar that you spend with them. All of us buy groceries and gas...some of us use coupons...none of us would turn down "extra money"! You earn money for our school without spending a single additional penny.

We hope you'll try Scrip soon...we're sure you'll like it!

SCRIP TUITION CREDIT PROGRAM AGREEMENT
2016-17



The purpose of the Scrip Tuition Credit program is to allow Waukesha Catholic families to generate reductions in their family's tuition costs by purchasing Scrip cards. Scrip cards are gift cards provided to Waukesha Catholic at a discount by participating retailers. These cards are sold to and redeemed by Waukesha Catholic families at face value by the retailer. The difference between their cost and their redemption value (Scrip profit) is used by Waukesha Catholic to help offset the operating expenses, thereby helping to reduce the impact of tuition increases for all Waukesha Catholic families. In an effort to provide additional assistance to participating families, the Scrip Tuition Credit Program allows participating families to earn credit toward their 2017-18 tuition costs.

SCRIP TUITION CREDIT GUIDELINES

1. As stated above, Scrip generates funds by obtaining gift cards from participating merchants at a discount and selling them at face value to program participants. The difference between these amounts is the "Scrip profit".
2. A percentage of the Scrip profits will be shared with participating families in the form of Waukesha Catholic tuition credits. A participating family will receive 50% of the Scrip profit generated by their family's weekly order in the form of Waukesha Catholic tuition credits. The tuition credit will be accumulated from July 2016 through June 2017. The remaining profit will be used by Waukesha Catholic to offset operating expenses for all campuses within the Waukesha Catholic system.
3. The following example will illustrate the tuition credit calculation:

4. Participating families may accumulate tuition credits for up to 50% of their total Waukesha Catholic tuition cost.
5. Waukesha Catholic tuition credits earned during the 2016-17 school year will reduce the participating families' tuition costs for the 2017-18 school year. Tuition credits may be used to offset 2016-17 graduation costs, only in the event that a participating family is graduating their final child from Waukesha Catholic. Any credits earned in excess of the current year's graduation costs will be used to offset Waukesha Catholic operating costs.
6. Waukesha Catholic tuition credits are NOT redeemable for cash or available to reduce any other expenses, except as described above.
7. The Scrip profit generated by each participating family will be accounted for on a weekly basis. Participating families may log-in on their SHOP WITH SCRIP account to view up to date tuition credit information. Select the "Family Order Rebate Summary Report" and enter in the dates you're interested in viewing. Remember that tuition credit is half the rebate amount. Please keep the yellow family packing slip that your Scrip order come with each week. This is your verification of what you received.
8. To be eligible for the Waukesha Catholic tuition credit to take effect during the 2017-18 school year, your family's total, yearly, tuition credit amount must be at least \$30.00. This means the amount for the whole year is \$30 or more.
9. As the Scrip Tuition Credit Program evolves, additional guidelines, regulations, etc., may be identified and implemented at anytime.
10. Waukesha Catholic is not responsible for any expired, lost or stolen cards. Use cards on a timely basis. Waukesha Catholic is not responsible for unused cards from discontinued business.
