Student Service Hours FAQ

How many service hours do I need to complete?

- 6th grade students need to complete 5 hours.
- 7th grade students need to complete 10 hours.
- 8th grade students need to complete 15 hours – 5 of which must be done outside of Waukesha Catholic.

Can service work that I did during the summer count for this year?

Yes, service work done during the summer can count for up to half of the required hours.

If I babysit my siblings, rake leaves in my yard, or wash my mother's car, can I count that for my service hours?

No. While it is certainly a nice thing to do for your family, we ask that the service hours be done outside of your immediate family/household.

Can I fulfill my service hours by doing one activity?

Yes.

Can I do service work during the school day?

No. All service work needs to be completed outside of the school day.

Can I submit service hours if I was paid or received something in return?

No. You can only submit service hours that you did without receiving compensation.

If I am an altar server for my parish on the weekends, can I count that time toward my service hours?

Yes.

If I am an altar server once a month, do I need to submit a reflection form each time I serve?

No, if you do the same service activity multiple times, you can submit one reflection form for all of those instances.
