

Updates/Reminders

Personnel Update: Please see below for personnel updates for the 2024-25 school year.

- Jen Kools, Middle School Teaching Assistant, will be leaving that role as she has decided she would prefer to return to substitute teaching. Good news is she will be available to sub!
- Olivia MacGillis, 3-8 grade Art teacher at St. Mary Campus, is resigning from her position at the end of the school year.
- Sue Bernhardt, EL Teaching Assistant at St. William, has decided to retire after a long-time career at Waukesha Catholic serving in many capacities.

Of course, we are saddened to see all three of these amazing women leave, but we are so grateful for their service, whether it be one year or many years, and for all they have done for the students at Waukesha Catholic.

Positions we will be hiring for the 2024-25 school year:

- Part-time Art: we will be hiring for a 0.6 FTE art position for grades 3-8
- Part-time Math Interventionist (0.6 FTE): for grades 3-8. This is a new position to replace Jen Kools.
- Mrs. Lourdes Marquez will replace Sue Bernhardt as the EL TA at St. William, and therefore we will be hiring for a **full-time Kindergarten teaching assistant**.
- **Speech Pathologist** Either hiring or contracting with a 0.4 FTE speech pathologist this is a new position funded by the SNSP program.

If you or anyone you know may be interested in any of the above mentioned positions, please refer them to me. The jobs will be posted on the Archdiocese of Milwaukee website and WECAN later this week or early next.

Teacher Requests: As we look towards the end of another great year, we as staff begin to think about student placement for the 2024-25 school year. The administration, in consultation with the present classroom teacher(s), works very diligently to determine student placement for the fall. As we do this, we carefully consider the academic, personal, social-emotional, and any other related learning needs of the individual student, along with the teaching style and personality of the teachers in the next grade. The teachers at Waukesha Catholic are dedicated individuals who have the best interest of each and every student in mind. Their judgment is important in student placement, and they take this task very seriously.

Due to our knowledge and understanding of the students, classroom teachers, classroom dynamics, and curriculum expectations, placement requests will **ONLY be considered for significant extenuating circumstances** and if the rationale is justified. If you feel you have adequate reason to make a request, it must be made utilizing the Teacher Request Form available by emailing Lynda Baumann at lbaumann@waukeshacatholic.org. These requests are due no later than **Monday, May 13**. All placement decisions are final. Thank you for your understanding, cooperation, and trust in this process.

Safe Environment Program

Did You Know...

All clergy, employees, and volunteers are required to meet all of the requirements of safe environment certification. Certification includes participating in training on recognizing signs of abuse and neglect, identifying grooming behaviors, training in maintaining boundaries, and mandatory reporting; reviewing the Code of Ethical Standards and the Social Media and Digital Communication Policy, and undergoing a criminal background check. Certification is required prior to beginning ministry and subsequently every five years.

Did You Know...

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has a Victim Assistance Coordinator that assists survivors of sexual abuse to navigate through the process of reporting abuse and receiving counselling services. The Victim Assistance Coordinator can be reached at 414-758-2232. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee also has a third-party reporting mechanism for misconduct through Convercent. All mandatory reporting laws in the State of Wisconsin are required to be followed with all reports to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee or Convercent. A report of abuse can also be made through the Advocate Aurora Healing Center or directly reported to the appropriate civil authorities.

Busing Request Form – Due by Wednesday, May 15!

The Waukesha School District provides busing to our students who live further than two miles from the campus they will be attending. (To see campus boundaries - <u>click here</u>.) The school district REQUIRES that all students needing busing for the 2024-25 school year complete the form at the link below.

If you do not complete this form, your child(ren) WILL NOT receive busing until that paperwork is processed. If you think you might need busing in the fall, complete this form ASAP but **no later than Wednesday, May 15, 2024.**

Alternate Location/Day Care Request

Use this form if you would like to use the shuttle to SWC instead of your AM or PM bus route. Students will only be routed to/from one (1) AM location and one (1) PM location Monday - Friday.

This form is due no later than **Sunday**, **June 30**, **2024**. If this form is received **after Sunday**, **June 30** it will remain in the que until paperwork is processed after school begins in the fall.
