Kovaleski's "Key" Notes

Dear Parents:

Catholic Schools Week officially begins this coming weekend! Our theme this year is: **Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. Succeed.** Here are just a few reminders of what to expect beginning this weekend:

- Join us for Mass and hospitality at one of our four supporting parishes and remember to show your school pride and earn a non-uniform pass by having your children wear their school uniform or Kindness Matters T-shirts! (We encourage parents that have Kindness Matters T-shirts to wear them, as well).

- The St. William and St. Mary Scholastic Book Fairs will be open after Masses this weekend. Make sure to stop by!
- St. William Campus Open House is this Sunday from 8:30 a.m. -11:30 p.m. We encourage you to stop by to visit your child's classroom. Should you know of anyone looking to enroll their children in 3K, 4K, or 5K please invite them to join you. This is a wonderful opportunity for them to tour the school, meet the teachers, and learn all about Waukesha Catholic.
- St. Mary Campus Open House is Monday, January 28th from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Again – all current families are encouraged to attend to “see” all the ways our students **learn – serve – lead – and succeed**. Please invite any prospective families you may know to join you!
- Other numerous activities will take place next week, as well. Please refer to the flyer included in today's Campus Connection.

At Waukesha Catholic we always strive to provide the best learning environment for all our learners. Since our return from Christmas break we have noticed many fashion or technological accessories our students are wearing that are causing either significant distractions or safety concerns in the school environment. Therefore, it has become necessary to address these concerns and make updates/clarifications as to what is allowable at school.

Headbands: Currently, our uniform policy states that “necklaces, headbands, and other accessories must never present a safety hazard or distraction.” Recently, we have seen an increase in “costume style” headbands (bunny ears, cat ears, unicorn horns, etc.) that have become a distraction and in some cases a safety concern. Therefore, effective immediately, this style of headband will not be allowed. We would request headbands be plain and simple in color and style.

Smartwatches: Although we recognize these have become very popular among the younger generation, these types of watches pose significant distractions and potential privacy concerns. For the same reasons we do not allow cell phones to be carried at school, we are unable to allow SmartWatches or any other “smart” device that allows for access to the internet (either via WiFi or a data plan), sends or receives text messages, and/or has picture taking capabilities. Ideally, these devices should be left at home, but if brought to school MUST remain in the student's backpack throughout the course of the school day.

We do understand that some students will be disappointed with our decision to prohibit these types of items. However, please know we do not make these decisions lightly. We take everything into consideration, have various discussions, and ultimately make our decisions based on what is best to ensure a proper and safe learning environment for all our students.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program

Attention parents of students entering K4, K5, or 1st Grade

Waukesha Catholic will continue to participate in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program for the 2019-20 school year. The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) allows students to attend Waukesha Catholic, tuition free, if certain eligibility criteria are met (see below). Waukesha Catholic, on behalf of the pupil's parent or guardian, receives a state aid payment for each eligible student. That aid payment or “voucher” covers the entire cost of the eligible student's tuition.

The open application period to apply for the WPCP begins February 1st and goes until April 20th, 2019. Please review the criteria below to determine if your child would qualify for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program.

WPCP Eligibility requirements:

- Students must reside in a Wisconsin school district outside of the Milwaukee Public Schools and Racine Unified School Districts. (Must live in a Wisconsin city that is not Milwaukee or Racine).

- For the 2019-20 school year, the family income of a student new to a choice program must be at or below the amount listed in the table below.
- Pupils applying for WPCP must meet at least **one** of the following attendance requirements:
 - Child is applying for K4, K5, or 1st grade at Waukesha Catholic for the 2019-20 school year.
 - Child participated in the WPCP in the 2018-19 school year.
 - Child was enrolled in a public school in Wisconsin in the 2018-19 school year.

WPCP 2019-20 Income Limits

(Please note that the income limits have gone up since last year. Please review carefully).

- For the 2019-20 school year, the family income of a student new to a choice program must be at or below the amount listed in the table below. Family income includes the income of the student's parent(s)/legal guardian(s) that reside in the same household as the student applicant. The Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) on the federal income tax return determines this income for the prior calendar year. (2018 calendar year for the 2019-20 school year).
- Family size includes parents/legal guardians and their children by birth, marriage or adoption that reside in the same household as the student applicant.
- If the student's parents/legal guardians that reside in the same household are married, they may reduce their income by \$7,000 when determining income eligibility for the program (i.e. a married family's income, as stated on your federal income taxes, minus \$7,000 is the income amount married families should compare to the tables below).

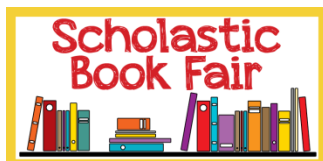
On February 7, 2019 all 7th & 8th graders are invited to visit Catholic Memorial to experience what a day as a CMH student is really like!
