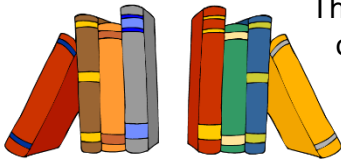

Student Selection of 2019-2020 Music Classes

Parents: after carefully reading through this document, please indicate your choice of music class on this form and return to your campus office by Friday, May 31, 2019

Please keep in mind the following when making your selection:

- Students at St. Joseph Campus satisfy our music curriculum requirements by taking Elements of Music, Choir or Band.
- All of these classes are a full-year commitment unless the teacher requests a change of schedule.

BAND

Band class meets twice a week and students will have scheduled individual and small group lessons each week.

All grade level bands are generally made up of students with at least one full year of playing experience. However, any “brand new” students wanting to learn an instrument for the first time are encouraged to join band too. It is never too late to learn how to play music through an instrument!

Instruments must be rented or purchased for Band. Waukesha Catholic has made efforts to add to the band instrument library. In the event that the extra cost of an instrument rental prevents a student from participating in our band program, there are a few school owned instruments that are available for use.

ELEMENTS OF MUSIC

Students in Elements of Music will be exposed to general topics in the discipline of music, including music theory and history. This will be supported through listening exercises, in-class work, homework, research and some projects.

Students in Elements of Music will be required to observe and review a concert during the second and third trimester. A list of concerts for this requirement will be provided. This class meets once per week.

CHOIR

In Choir, students will learn the basic techniques of singing, music theory, music history, and prepare songs for the Christmas concert, Spring concert and 8th grade graduation. Students will be assessed through the use of quizzes, tests, class participation, projects and performances. Practicing at home is monitored through the use of a practice journal. This class meets once per week.

BAND AND CHOIR

Students who are interested in being in band and choir may take both classes. Students in both classes will have band class only one day a week.
